The Scholarship

Recipients of the Data Analytics Diversity Scholarship will receive a full-tuition scholarship for the Data Analytics Fellowship program.

Students will be notified of their scholarship award when they receive their acceptance to the Fellowship program.

Recipients of the scholarship must attend the cohort for which they applied, are not able to defer to another session, must commit to all program requirements and must pay a nonrefundable \$250 deposit.

Eligibility

Applicants must meet the following criteria to be considered for the scholarship:

- Must be located in the U.S.
- Must identify with one or more of the following groups:
 - Women
 - Veterans
 - LGBTQ+
- Underrepresented ethnic and racial groups:
 - American Indian or Alaskan Native
 - Asian
 - Black and African American
 - Hispanic or Latino
 - Native Hawaiian or other Pacific Islander
- Must have a Bachelor's degree from an accredited university in a STEM-related field such as:
 - Science
 - Technology
 - Engineering
 - Math

Application

To be considered for the scholarship, you must include:

- A completed and submitted application to the Data Analytics Fellowship Program
- An up-to-date resume
- A completed and submitted scholarship application

Selection Process

Applicants will be selected to receive the scholarship based on:

- Eligibility requirements
- Academic background and record
- Work experience (6 months to 2 years of relevant work experience in a data role)
- Interview and presentation that showcases ability to communicate how to apply academic and work past to future career goals
